


## Day 3: Yangon

## Day 4: Yangon - Pyapon

Depart early from Yangon via the Twante Canal stopping at Twante to view the potteries before cruising on to Pyapon (64miles) a delightful delta town and seaport with lively docks and markets.


# Day 5: Pyapon - Bogale

Bogale is at the heart of the delta and was once a Mon capital and trading port connected to international trading routes between the 15th and 18th centuries.

Visit the Mein Ma Hla Kyun Wildlife Reserve, an island of just under one hundred square miles classified as a mangrove eco-system reserve and home to salt water crocodiles.

# Day 6: Bogale -Myaungmya

Today is perhaps the most fascinating days' sailing, weaving through creeks and channels cross-country across the heart of the delta.

Enjoy a stop for a walk in a suitable village.

# Day 7: Myaungmya -Bassein

Enjoy the morning cruise across the final section of delta to join the great Bassein River that leads up to Bassein, the capital of the delta and an important seaport.

Of interest here are the traditional umbrella manufacturies, where the typical monk's waxed cloth umbrellas are made. Explore the town, its shrines and vibrant markets on foot.

#### Day 8: Bassein

Spend the day at leisure in this charming port town with an optional day trip by car to Ngwe Saung Beach with lunch there.

## Day 9: Bassein - Wakema

A noon departure is followed by lunch.

Follow the Upper Delta route of the old IFC 'launch service' between Rangoon and Bassein with the evening to explore this attractive river port.

On these busier channels there is a variety of shipping whilst the riverbanks team with life and activity. Maubin is a very pleasant place to enjoy a sunset walk along its colourful strand.

#### Day 11: Maubin - Yangon

Enjoy the morning run crossing the Twante Canal and home to the Rangoon River and Pandaw's berth in colonial downtown Yangon.

Disembark between 12 and 12.30 pm (lunch excluded) and transfer to your chosen hotel in Yangon with the rest of the day at leisure.

Alternatively add on an excursion to ancient Arakan or the Golden Rock.

While the craft may be small, Pandaw has the highest passenger-to-deck- space ratio of almost any cruise ship afloat.



It all adds to the famous 'Pandaw spirit' that brings so many guests back on board time and time again.


Passengers are welcome to eat alone or with family or friends - in the dining room or on deck. Most dietary requirement are catered for.

Pandaw has an all-inclusive policy, meaing no hidden extras for excursions, and most drinks are included. While passengers are free to do their own thing on shore, transportation, sometimes in the form of a cyclo or sampan, is provided for those who prefer a guided excursion in the capable hands of Pandaw's expert guides.



Sailing on a Pandaw ship is an outdoor, fresh air experience. However comfortable and roomy the staterooms, passengers tend to prefer to spend time sitting outside, on the promenade decks or on the vast observation deck above.

Unlike most other cruise ships, every window on board (except for the portholes on the lower deck) can be opened and closed to suit your comfort.




The Irrawaddy Delta Cruises are on the RV Katha, the third Katha to run on the Irrawaddy (the first was built in 1887).

16 cabins are spread across an Upper and Lower Deck and all feature panoramic French windows.

The Katha has no formal indoor dining room, which is ideal for cruising the Delta as it is more pleasant to eat outside than in a stuffy, noisy enclosed dining room.

The ship has quality mountain bikes for your independent exploration.



Many passengers describe life on board Pandaw as more like being a guest on a private yacht, than a passenger on a conventional cruise ship. Pandaw itineraries strive to include the most spectacular sights and experiences - far more intrepid than conventional cruises.
